

## AUTHOR GUIDELINES

### manuscripts should be submitted to:

Submit manuscripts in electronic format to [ybuchner@gmail.com](mailto:ybuchner@gmail.com), including figures and tables, saved in MS Word or Rich Text Format. (Manuscripts submitted by e-mail should not be sent by regular mail.) Each manuscript must be accompanied by a submission letter and a signed Copyright Release. Authors should report any potential conflicts of interest, including interests relevant to the topic of the manuscript, in a footnote on the first page.

### editorial policy

Reviews considered for publication may address any subject within the scope of the journal and must be based on published articles but can contain new data from the author's own laboratory. Full-length research papers will also be considered for publication and are subject to review. Manuscripts are received with the understanding that they have not been published previously in another journal or news media nor are under consideration for publication elsewhere. Manuscripts become the permanent property of REH and cannot be published elsewhere without written permission from the author and the journal. Papers involving multiple authorship are received with the understanding that all authors have approved the final submitted manuscript and concur in its submission to REH and agree that the corresponding author has the authority to act on their behalf on all matters pertaining to the publication of the manuscript. The journal is not responsible for lost manuscripts. Accepted manuscripts will be published within 6 months of acceptance.

### transfer of author copyright

Please include a **signed release of copyright** to Freund Publishing House, Ltd. Include the title of the article, date submitted, and signatures of all co-authors. The corresponding author is responsible for obtaining written permissions from both the original publisher and the original author [the copyright owner(s)] to reproduce figures, tables, or text from previous publications.

### organization and format

**REH** format follows the "Uniform requirements for manuscripts submitted to biomedical journals" (<http://www.icmje.org/>). Type the entire manuscript in English, using double-line spacing. The title page should include a short, succinct title, a short running title, name and affiliation of each author, and mailing address(es) of the institution(s) at which the work was performed. List the mailing address, fax number, and e-mail address of the corresponding author. List five or six **keywords that do not appear in the title.**

### review papers

A comprehensive review paper should summarize and put into perspective the most recent published developments in a defined subject area or the work of a particular individual or group, including the author's own group. Use subheadings to guide the reader. As a review paper serves as a tutorial, provide background information on the chemical properties of pollutants, environmental fate, transport, sources, routes of exposure, and adverse health effects. Avoid scientific jargon and wordiness. The significance of the work should be apparent to readers outside your field—**write like a teacher!**

Full-length original research papers relating to environmental health should include the following elements:

**Summary, Keywords, Introduction, Experimental, Results, Discussion, Acknowledgments, References.**

**Summary must be 200 words or less.** Avoid abbreviations and references; the abstract will be published separately by abstracting services and must be understandable without reference to the text.

**References** must be numbered consecutively in the text, inside slashes /1, 2, 3/, and listed on a separate sheet in numerical order. For more than six authors, list the first six names followed by et al. Abbreviations of journal names should conform to the *Index Medicus*. Use the *PubMed* format, as shown in the examples below:

### Journal Article, 1 to 6 authors: (list all 6 authors)

1. Moldofsky H. Fibromyalgia and chronic fatigue syndrome. *Adv Neuroimmunol.* 1995;5:39-56.

### Journal Article, more than 6 authors: (6 authors, et al.)

2. Opler MG, Buka SL, Groeger J, McKeague I, Wei C, Factor-Litvak P, et al. Prenatal exposure to lead, delta-Aminolevulinic Acid, and schizophrenia: Further evidence. *Environ Health Perspect.* 2008 116(11):1586-90.

### Book, single author:

3. Shepard TH. *Catalog of teratogenic agents.* 7th ed. Baltimore: Johns Hopkins Press; 1992;534p.

### Book, multiple authors:

4. Baselt RC, Cravey RH. *Disposition of toxic drugs and chemicals in man.* 4th ed. Foster City (CA): Chemical Toxicology Institute; 1995;802 p.

### Edited book:

5. Armitage JO, Antman KH, editors. *High-dose cancer therapy: pharmacology, hematopoietins, stem cells.* Baltimore: Williams & Wilkins; 1995;929 p.

### Article in edited book:

6. Farrar WV, Williams AR. A history of mercury. In: McAuliffe, ed, *The Chemistry of Mercury.* London, UK: McMillan Press, 1990;151-158.

### Monographic series

7. Davidoff RA. Migraine: manifestations, pathogenesis, and management. Philadelphia: F.A.Davis; 1995;375 p. (Contemporary neurology series; 42).

### Internet citation:

Cite in text inside parenthesis (<http://www.nlm.nih.gov/>). Do not add to list of references.

**Personal communications and manuscripts submitted for publication.** Cite in text (inside parentheses). Do not add to list of references.

### illustrations and tables

The dimensions of figures and tables must not exceed 17 cm x 21 cm. Number figures with Arabic numerals and cite in text (Figure 1). List figure legends on a separate page. Submit graphs, charts and other drawings as computer-graphics or photographs imbedded in an MS Word document. Lettering must be legible in the final size of figures. Tables should not duplicate information in the text.

### manuscript editing

The editors reserve the privilege of editing the manuscript to conform to concise, standard U.S. English usage and the stylistic conventions of this journal.
